



Role Description: 2nd Africa Rover Moot Camp Chief

The Africa Rover Moot is a gathering of Rover Scouts, under the auspices of the Africa Scout Region, and held every 3 years. The 2nd Africa Moot will be hosted by SCOUTS South Africa in 2026 at Arrowe Park Scout Grounds, Benoni, Gauteng between 31 July 2026 to 9 August 2026 (subject to change)

Role Purpose: (non-exhaustive and may be updated as needed)

- To lead and manage all aspects of the camp's operations, ensuring the successful execution of the 2nd ARM in accordance with SSA Constitution, Organisational Rules, and Policies.
- To represent the interests and views of the 2nd ARM Organising Committee in all interactions and communications.

Functions:

- **Meetings:** Attend meetings of the Organising Committee and provide updates as required.
- **Planning:** Collaborate to create comprehensive plans for all camp aspects.
- **Execution:** Oversee setup, maintenance, and effective implementation of camp activities.
- **HS&E:** Coordinate with the HS&E representative to ensure the safety & well-being of all.
- **Contingency:** Develop and implement plans to address potential challenges.
- **Recruiting:** Recruit and train a team of individuals to manage various aspects of camp life.
- **Leadership:** Supervise and support your team in managing their respective areas.
- **Finances:** Manage the budget effectively, ensuring responsible and efficient use of resources.
- **Resources:** Collaborate with other teams to identify, source, and allocate necessary resources.
- **Other duties:** Perform other duties as may reasonably be required to ensure a successful event.

- Have held a similar role for a large event or have experience in planning of large events
