

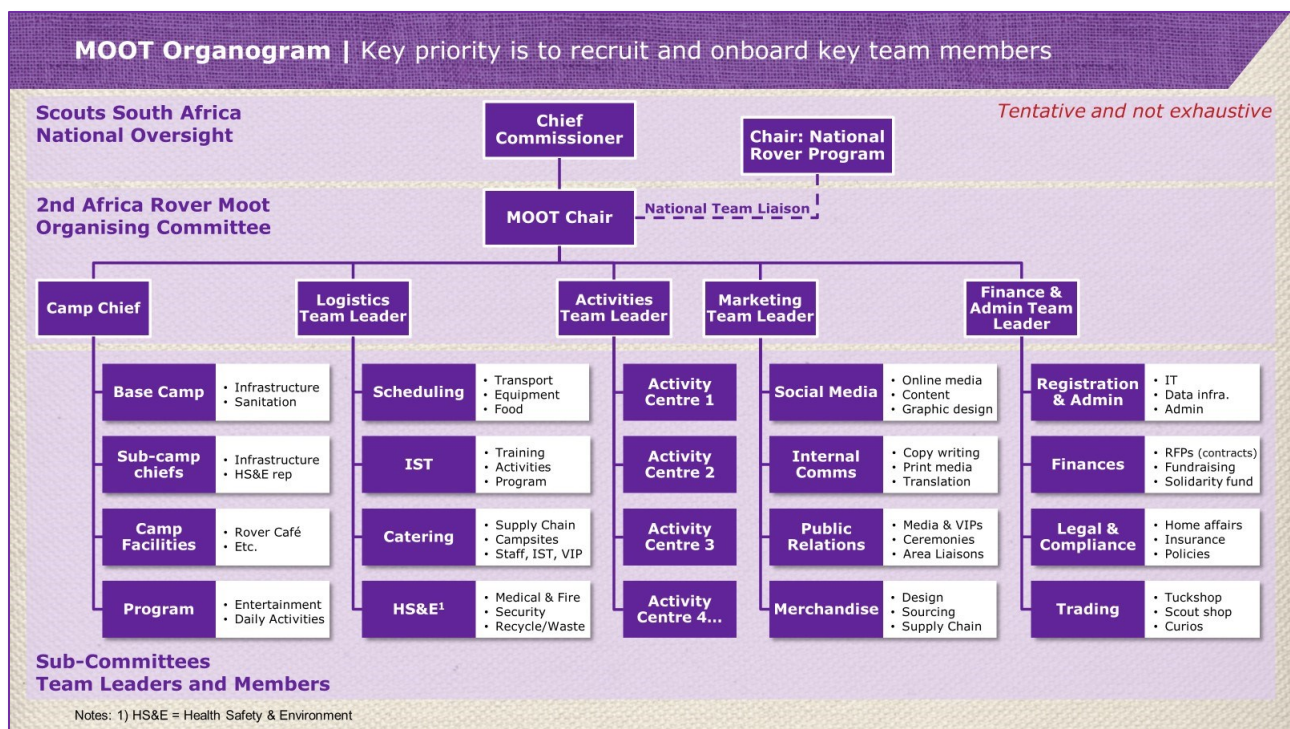


Role Description: 2nd Africa Rover Moot Sub-Committee Team Leader or Member

Role Purpose:

- Work collaboratively within sub-committees to plan, organise, and deliver key aspects of the event.
- Sub-committees include Activities, Campsites, Logistics, Marketing, and Finance & Administration.

1. **Meetings:** Attend meetings and provide update
2. **Planning:** Collaborate with other teams to ensure seamless event delivery
3. **Execution:** Assist with successful execution of the 2nd Africa Rover Moot
4. **HS&E:** Ensure adherence to safety and well-being standards
5. **Contingency:** Assist in the developing and implementing plans to address potential challenges
6. **Recruiting:** Recruit and train team members (if applicable)
7. **Leadership:** Supervise and support team members (if applicable)
8. **Finances:** Manage budgets and resources effectively
9. **Resources:** Collaborate with other teams to identify, source, and allocate necessary resources
10. **Other Duties:** Perform other duties as may reasonably be required to ensure a successful event
