



Role Description

National Coordinator: Growth (National Partner Engagement)

Role Purpose:

The purpose of the role is to work together with the existing support structures of SCOUTS South Africa to grow Scouting with support and engagement with and by Government departments and other relevant partners.

To investigate and advise SSA on potential NGO partnerships and growth opportunities that should be supported in line with the growth strategy.

To develop SSA's capability and capacity to support growth initiatives across regions.

Functions:

1. Identify Growth Opportunities

- Engage with and develop relationships with key third party organisations and establish formal partnership agreements, with a view to establishing Groups with third party support.
- Support the Regions and work to establish a pipeline of potential growth projects (linked to partners and local government) and develop and grow Scouting within all regions

2. Develop and Enhance SSA's Internal 'Growth' Capability

- Develop an approach to dealing with enquiries from interested parties, to ensure that these are logged and recorded, dealt with consistently by the Regional Teams, whilst providing the necessary visibility at a national level.
 - Through regular engagements, discuss potential growth opportunities within regions and the role that local government / third party organisations can play.
 - Perform / implement any project / task / assignment as required by the CEO.
3. Have regular meetings with the CEO to discuss successes, challenges and support required in the role. This should include a personal 'Moments that Matter' discussion.
