# REGISTRATION PROCESS

Kindly follow the steps below in order to register for the 2nd Africa Scout Moot

1. Navigate to the 2nd Africa Moot Registration [website](#) to create an account. Select the blue "create an account" option, where you will then be required to enter a few details and create a password.

2. Verify your email address. Find the email asking you to complete your account registration. You will need to click the provided link to activate your account.

3. Login to the moot website and register by doing the following below:

- Click on 'Event Registration' on the dark blue strip at the top of the page.
- Click on 'Enrol' on the green button.
- Know whether you are applying as a Participant or an International Staff Team (ICT) member.

4. Fill out all required information such as:

- Personal Information.
- Country.
- Emergency Information and Medical History
- Religion and dietary requirements.
- Letter of good standing.











5. Repeat the above for further Participants or International Staff Team (IST).

6. Submit your application - you will receive a notification if there are any errors in your application. Please correct any errors.

7. You're done. Good job!

The above Schedule outlines national passport holders from countries who are exempt from port of entry visa requirements, the category of passport holders who are exempt from port of entry visa requirements and the period for which such visa exemption applies. Where a national passport holder of a specific country is required to be in possession of a port of entry visa to proceed to South Africa, the list also outlines whether or not an administrative processing fee is payable or not. Please note that countries marked with an asterisk are only subject to visa fees if the intended visit exceeds thirty (30) days.

All travellers to South Africa are advised that if you are the holder of a national passport of a country whose passport holders are exempt from visa requirements, but your individual visa exemption has been officially withdrawn, a port of entry visa application must be submitted through the South African Embassy/ High Commission/ Consulate General in your country of origin or of long-term residence.

# GENERAL FAQ's

## How many people are we allowed to bring?

Contingents are not limited to size, and we understand that Rovers are a flexible and changeable age group with varying needs. Anywhere from three to one thousand is welcome.

## When can IST register?

Registrations for all IST, Participants and Individuals will open on the 15<sup>th</sup> of February and close at the end of April 2026.

## Do participants pay any fees as individuals to you directly?

This depends on each contingent's financial structure. We expect one bulk payment from contingents and if you do not have a contingent, you will pay directly into the event bank account.

## Do you anticipate a point of contact person needing to undertake any coordination activities at the event?

By "point of contact" we assume you refer to a person that is traveling with your contingent to coordinate and liaise between the organising team and the participants. Yes, it will take mutual work and effort on behalf of the organising teams and CMT/ IST's to make this event a success for the participants.

## How many IST's are we allowed to register within one contingent?

Try not to have more IST/CMT than participants, but of course for smaller countries, there can be some flexibility around this.



# GENERAL FAQ's

## That there were some different categories with different prices, what's the differences between those?

WOSM has outlined a categorisation of countries due to a few factors, mainly socio-economic, which dictates the categorisation process. Your international commissioner can advise on this and on which category your NSO is. This is to allow equity and accessibility for various countries to be granted opportunities to attend these amazing events. ## What is the provisional timeline for payments?

You will be invoiced after you register and the soonest you can start to pay is the 15<sup>th</sup> of February. The final payment date is the 30<sup>th</sup> of April 2026

## What are the indicative arrival and departure dates?

IST Registrations take place on the 30<sup>th</sup> of July, and training for IST is on the 31<sup>st</sup> of July. Participants arrive and register on the 1<sup>st</sup> of August. Kindly take these dates into consideration with your plans.

## Clarification on any additional fees participants should anticipate.

Kindly note that we are still working on the costs of the Moot for the IST training dates, as this could include additional camping and food costs. Contingents are also welcome to take advantage of the beauty of South Africa and plan either a pre/ post- tour which is will of course be additional and at the discretion of each contingent.



## Any preliminary logistical guidance that may assist with travel and budget planning.

Kindly note that in our social media and bulletins there will be travel information, kit lists, data and connectivity costs, travel costs etc. We will also dedicate a HOC meeting to this topic so that contingents can be kept up to date.

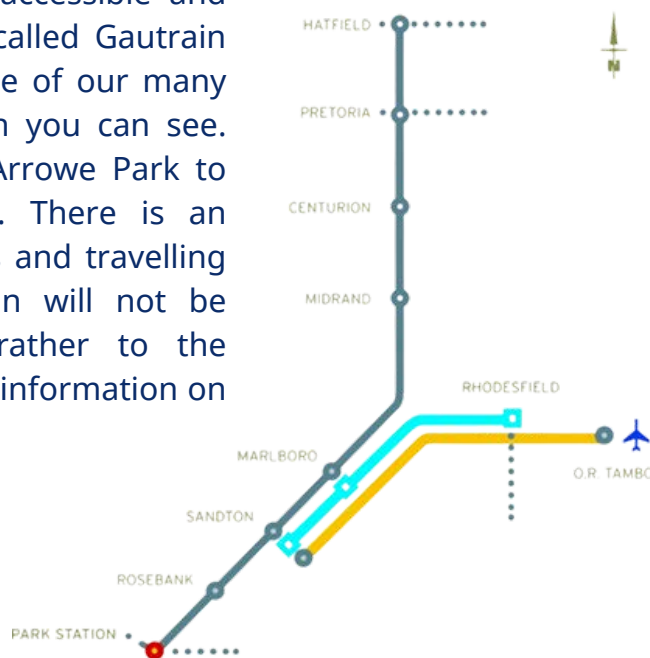
## Prepare accurate budgets for participants, including anticipated costs for local transport

More information regarding accommodation and catering before the Moot will be made available as soon as we can plan some logistical factors. For transportation to get to and from the Arrowe Park Campsite, we recommend using Uber or Bolt through the use of an their respective Apps. Both E-hailing Apps are easily accessible and affordable options for transportation.

The Johannesburg food scene is alive with tantalising options, and we can share more information and recommendations closer to the time. We will also provide a list with supermarket recommendation.

Public transportation is, unfortunately, inaccessible and unreliable. We have a local train service called Gautrain with routes that take you to and from one of our many larger Towns. Below is an example which you can see. Kindly note it is cheaper to travel from Arrowe Park to Rhodesfield than to OR Tambo airport. There is an additional cost placed on airport transfers and travelling to the airport to travel on the Gautrain will not be necessary; save the cost and travel rather to the Rhodesfield station. ### Do all people (participants, IST, CMT) need a letter of good standing?

Yes. Every person (Participant, IST, CMT) requires a letter of good standing from their NSO. This must be uploaded during registration.

### When will we receive visa letters?

Visa letters of invitation will be sent out after registration closes (April 30) and the registration list has been vetted.

### Can we pay individually?

While possible for single attendees, we strongly prefer bulk invoicing per contingent to streamline the process

### Does the event cost include airport transfers?

No. The fee covers the programme and food from the 1st to the 8th. Transport to/from the airport or for pre/post tours must be arranged by the contingent (e-hailing is available).

## Can participants choose their activities?

Yes. After registration, participants will rank their top 3 preferences for the overnight adventure. Organisers will try to assign their 1st or 2nd choice.

## Can IST participate in off-site activities?

Likely yes for most activities, though some (like the nature reserve) have capacity limits. Details to be confirmed.

## Are the activities safe?

Yes. Venues are secure (fenced reserves/campsites), and specialised security and chartered transport will be used

## Do participants need to bring their own tents?

Yes. Because of the mixed patrol system, you will not be camping with your contingent. You must bring your own small hiking tent (avoid large family tents).

## What is the temperature going to be like?

It will be late winter/early spring. Expect warm, sunny days (mid-20°C) but cold nights (dropping to approx. 5°C). Frost is possible at night

## Can we arrive early?

Yes. Camping at Arrowe Park will likely be available for early arrivals (from July 30 for IST). This will be at an extra cost and likely self-catered.

## Will there be a flag parade?

Yes. Please bring your national flags if you are coming from **outside of Africa**. Specific sizes and formats will be communicated later.

## Should we complete Safe From Harm training now?

No. Please wait. There will be an event-specific pre-training course that covers Safe From Harm and other requirements, and this will be communicated at a later stage.
