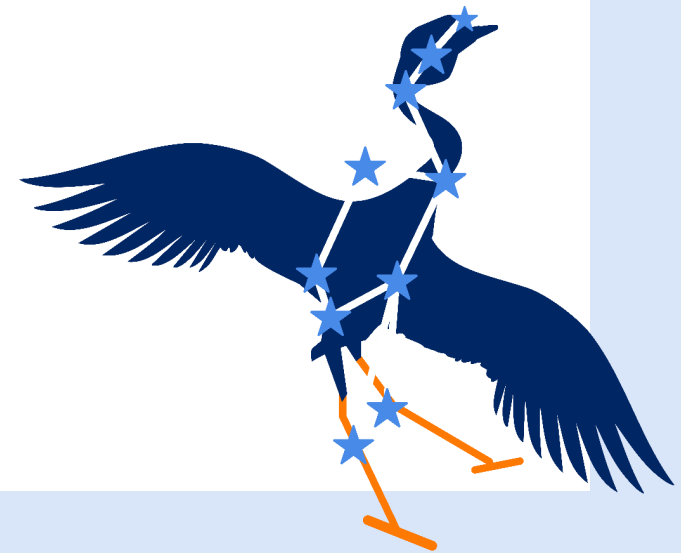
## Solidarity Opportunities

- Get one FREE participant for every 10 Fully Paid participants i.e. pay for 10 get 1 free



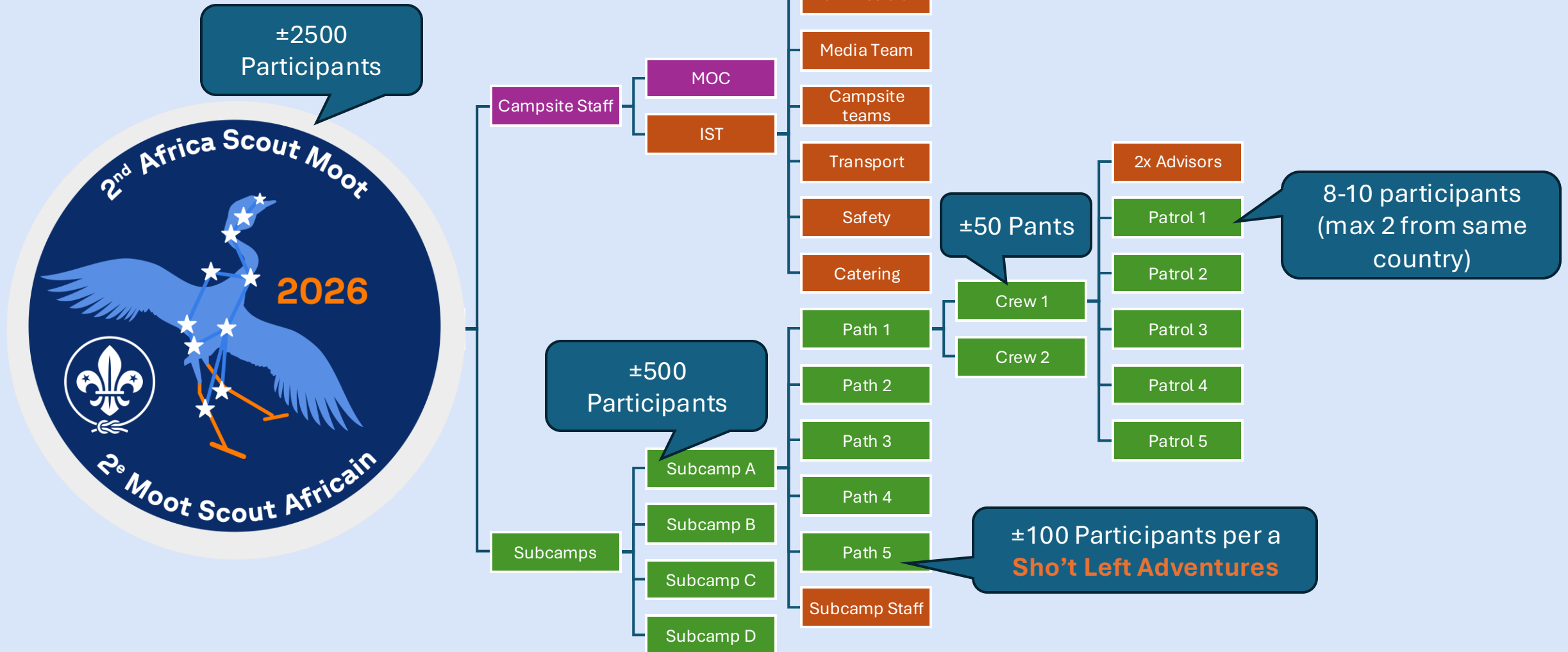

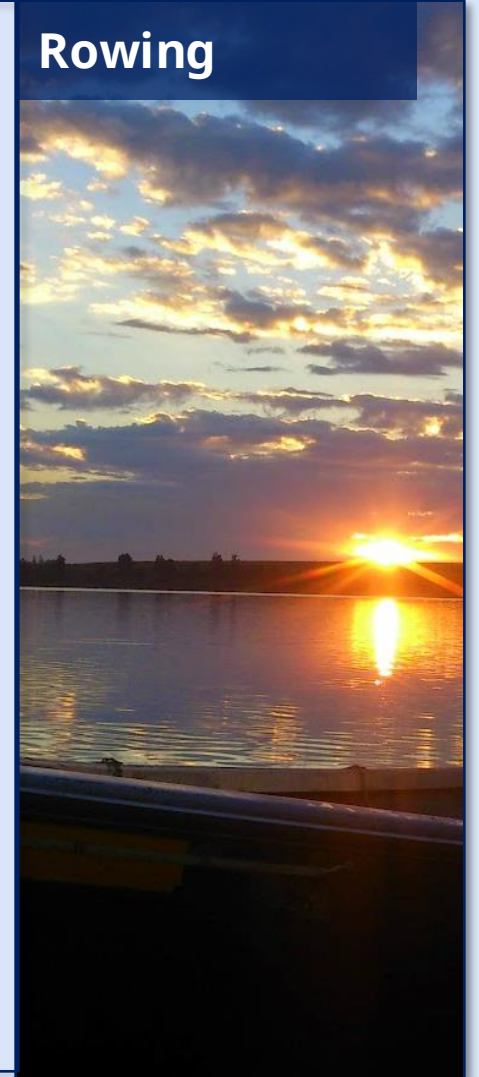

- Patrols will be assembled based on Sho't Left choices and you will camp with your patrol for those activities
- Specific equipment and pre-event training will be communicated for your chosen adventure

- Engage with NPO partners and WOSM programmes



# Egoli - Joburg City Tour



## Ponte Tower & Hillbrow

- Explore a 54 storey building overlooking the Johannesburg CBD which has its own Scout Troop
- Visit the surrounding neighbourhood, a centre for culture and food from across Africa



## Modderfontein

- Explore this small village nestled between lakes near Johannesburg
- Baden-Powell lived here from 1900-1907 and many sites, including the house where he lived, and his favourite campsite, are preserved



## Soweto

- Visit the iconic Vilakazi street, home to 2 Nobel Peace Prize winners
- Learn more about the 1976 Soweto uprising
- Experience Soweto's vibrant culture
