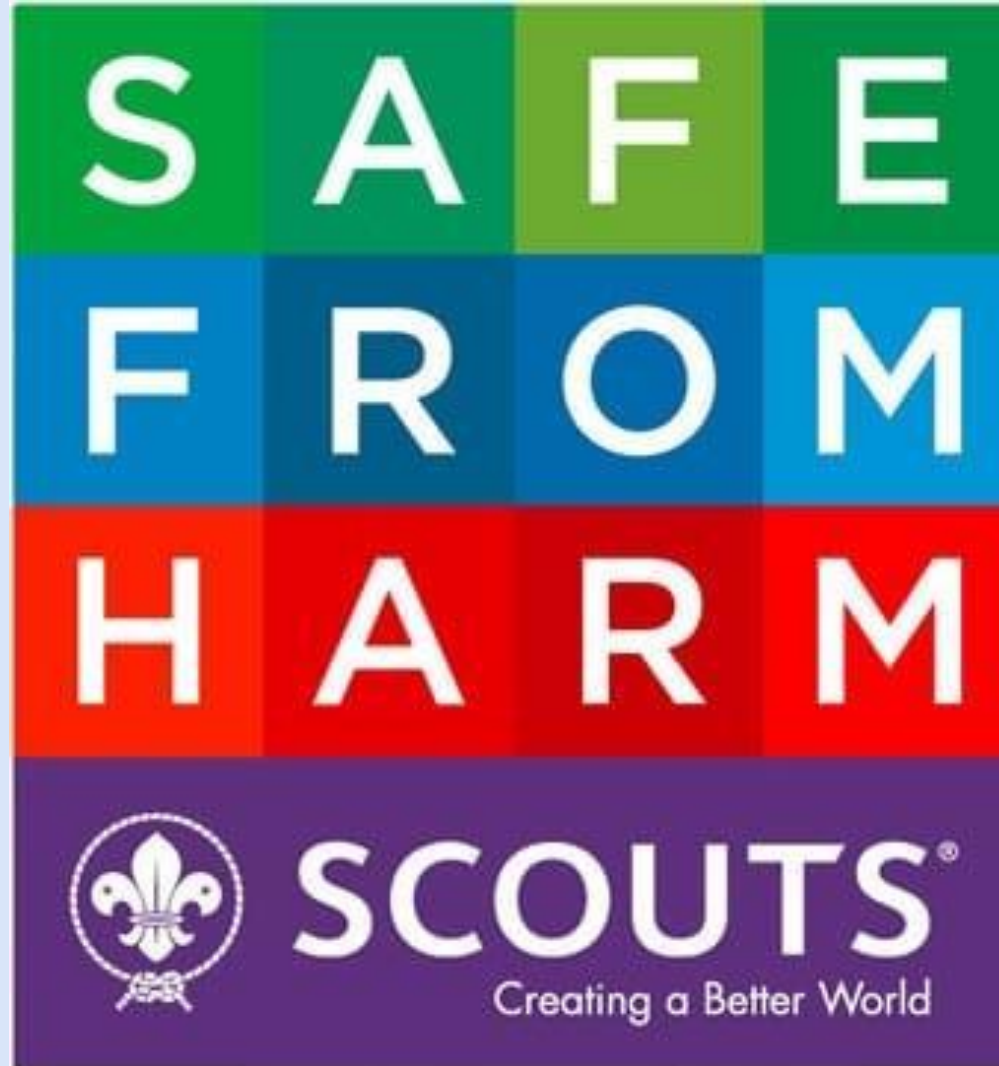

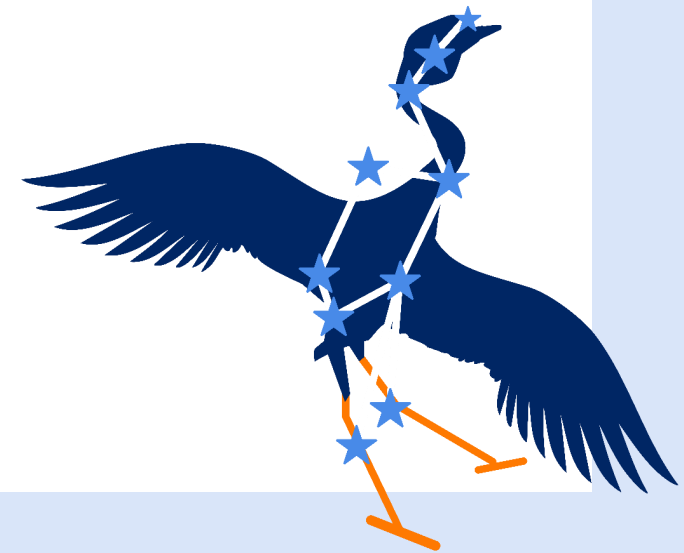
## Solidarity Opportunities

- C + D categories can opt to donate their discount to the solidarity fund to further assist attendance from A + B countries

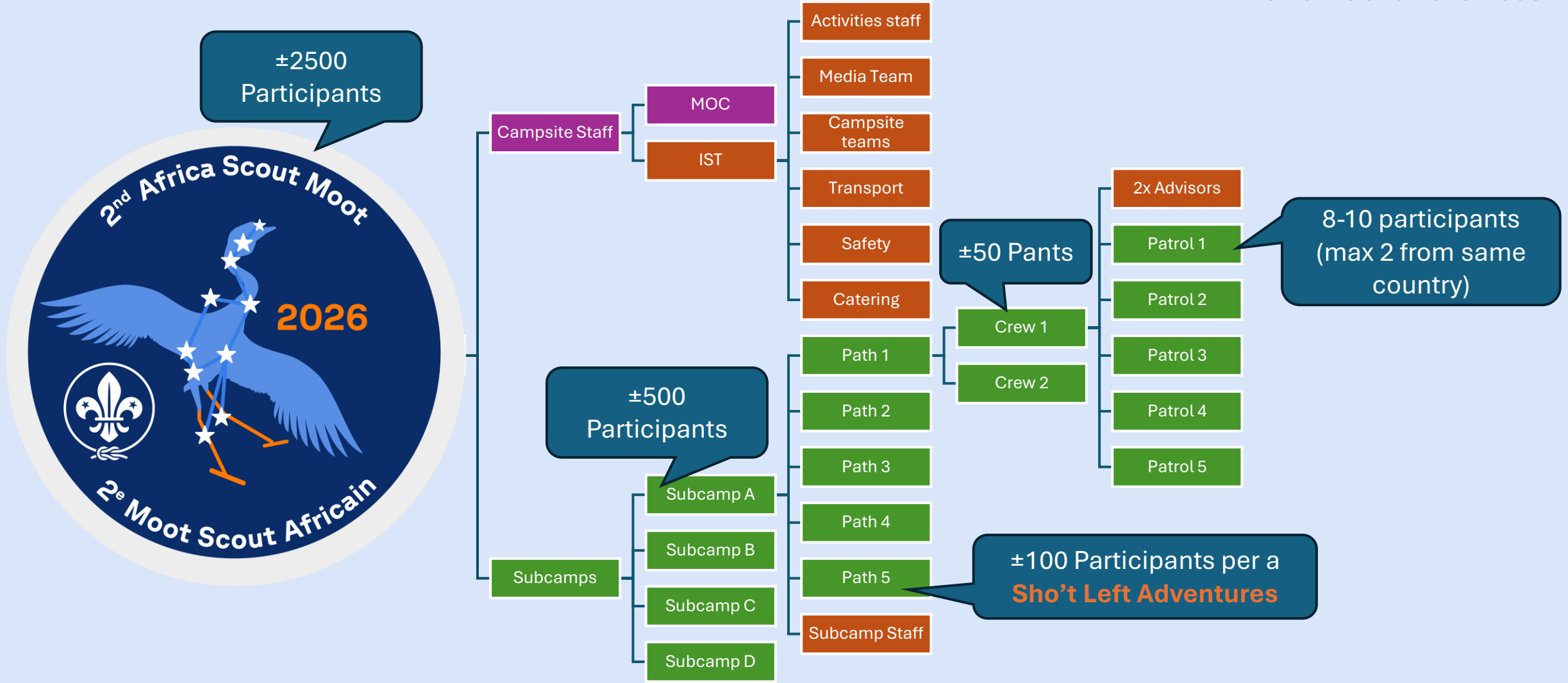
### 10 + 1 Deal

- Get one FREE participant for every 10 Fully Paid participants i.e. pay for 10 get 1 free

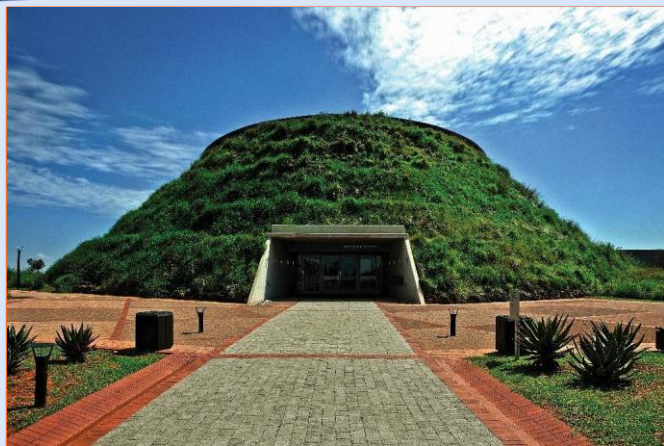

**Mealtimes on Scouting events are important because they provide times for Tribes to work together and build friendships, aside from just providing nourishment!**

## **Key points:**

- All participant meals will be cooked by the participants themselves
- Participants will cook in their Crews of +/-50 people – not in Contingents
- All cooking equipment will be provided (pots, pans, cookers, etc)
- Cooking will be done on gas – no fires
- All participants will need to bring mess kits – bowl/plate and cutlery
- Menu will be shared prior to the start of the event but will be easy to cook and nutritious
- For meals while away from the campsite, participants will be given the opportunity to make meals the morning of their departure and/or provided with meals at their overnight location



## Food supplies

- Participants will collect their food supplies twice per day – once for breakfast and lunch supplies, and once for supper supplies
- Food will be supplied in boxes with all ingredients pre-packed for each individual Crew
- Supply boxes will need to be collected by each tribe from the designated supply collection spot at the times as per the programme



## IST Catering Arrangements

- ISTs will be catered for by a central kitchen and will not need to cook themselves
- For meals away from camp, ISTs will be provided with pre-packed meals
- ISTs and participants will largely eat the same meals on the same days



## Special Dietary Requirements

- All reasonable efforts will be made to accommodate the dietary requirements of all participants and IST
- Please ensure that we are aware of all special dietary requirements
- Alternative menu options will be made available for dietary requirements such as Halaal and vegetarian.

Less common special dietary requirements will be handled on a case-by-case basis

- Food allergies will be taken into account
- Our aim is for a feeling of inclusion – so we will do our best to accommodate everyone's needs

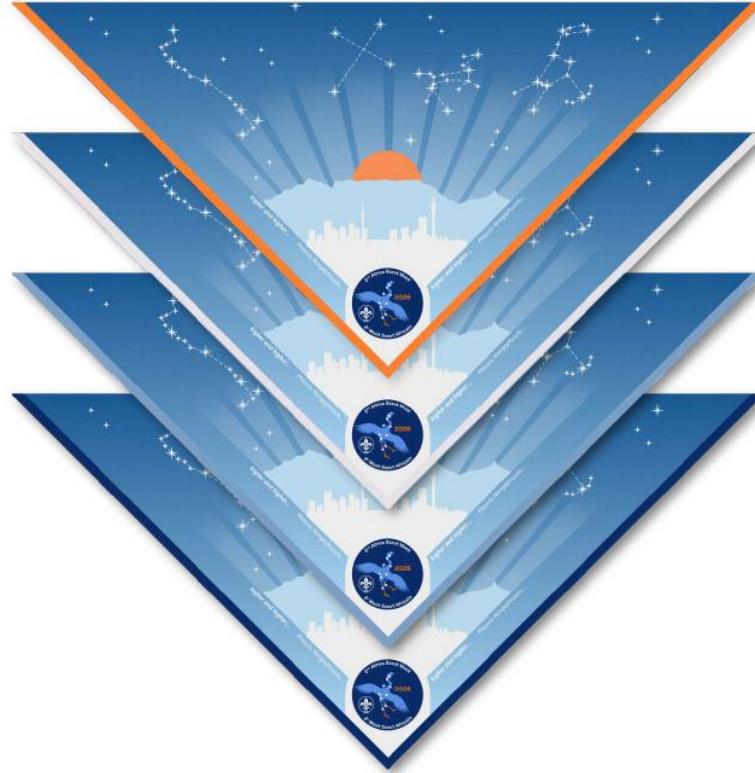
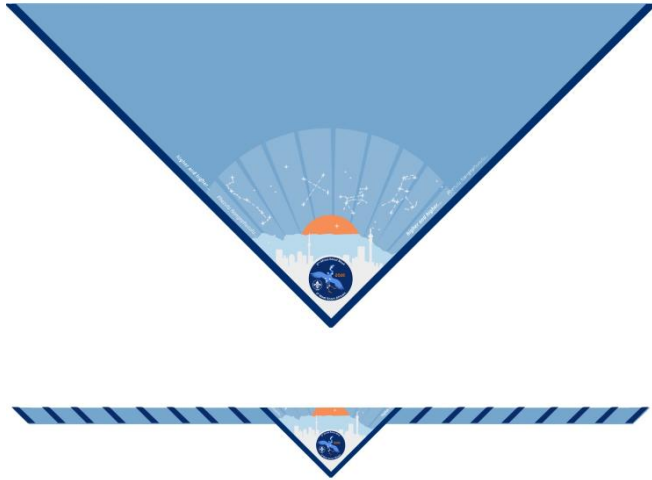


**Organised transport on the Moot will be provided to all off-site activities by bus.**

## **Key points:**

- All activities off-site will have pre-arranged transport from the campsite to the activity and back
- ISTs will be assigned to ensure the right people are on the right bus at the right time
- 60 seater buses will primarily be used
- No transport is provided to and from the campsite for the start and the end – this is up to each contingent
- We are able to put you in touch with local charter bus companies should you wish, to arrange your own transport (contingent size dependent)
