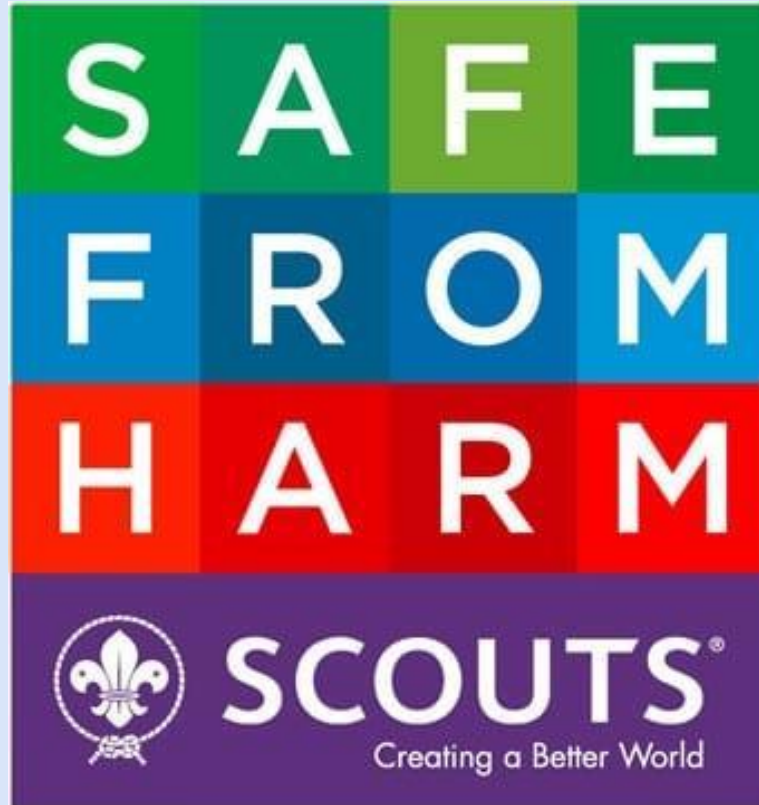

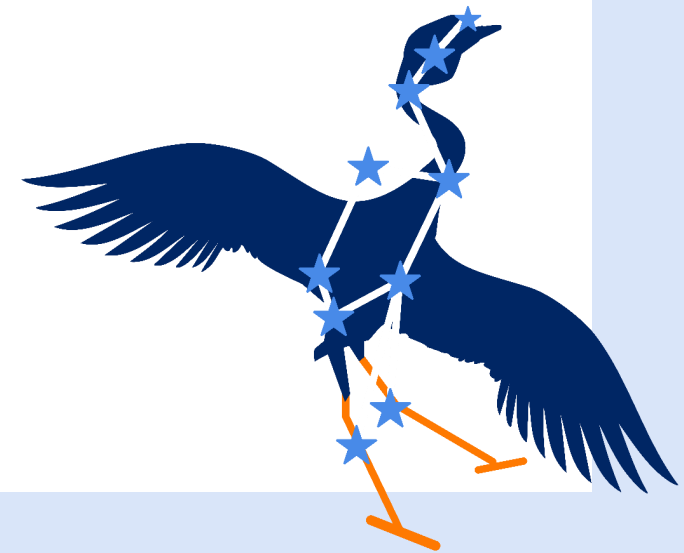
Early Payment Discount
