Moments that Matter can be described as times of importance during your Scouting Journey; memorable moments that will leave a lasting effect on you and hopefully give you a better understanding of the Movement, your successes as well as a desire to be more involved.

MOMENTS THAT MATTER

"A Moment that Matters" is a time when you sit with your next-in-line scouter and have an informal discussion about your time in Scouting over the past few months or year. We care about your future in Scouting and we would like you to take the time to chat to us about how we can improve; how you feel you can improve; and how together we can achieve these ideas.

Ideally these meetings should happen once a year. It is likely that your next in line scouter will suggest a meeting, but if they do not, and you want to meet, then set up a meeting.

At that meeting there should be two-way feedback and agreed action items to enhance Scouting for you and for your fellow Scouters. There will also be a Moment that Matters when you are applying to renew your warrant or are looking to change roles when your current warrant expires.

This form can be filled out by you and sent to your next-in-line scouter prior to the meeting or it can be discussed at the meeting.

Please note: In the interim, and until the next updating of the Adult Support Policy, there might be instances where the words "PDR" (Personal Development Review) appear. These will be updated in due course to read "Moments that Matter"
