The Challenge:

There are four sections to the 2021 challenge, covering the following Sustainable Development Goals:

Section 1: Clean Water and Sanitation – SDG 6

Requirements:

Complete **ONE** requirement applicable to the branch you are working in:

1. Design a game for your Den/Pack/Troop/Crew that highlights that water is very precious and not readily accessible by all.
2. For the Den or Pack, create a programme around why water is so important and what happens when we have run out.
OR
3. For the Troop or Crew, write up a programme that focusses on creating awareness around water related ecosystems. What can be done to save these?



Section 2: Affordable and Clean Energy – SDG 7

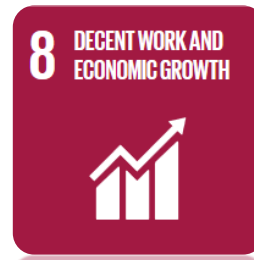
Requirements:

Complete **ONE** requirement applicable to the branch you are working in:

1. Design a movable toy that the Den/Pack can make using sustainable energy – perhaps the wind – that they can have fun with.
OR
2. Design a solar powered item that the Troop/Crew can build for a strategic use or just for fun.
3. Write a programme for your branch dealing solely with how pollution destroys both the body and the earth.



Section 3: Decent Work & Economic Growth – SDG 8



Requirements:

Complete **ONE** requirement applicable to the branch you are working in:

1. In your branch, be it Den/Pack/Troop/Crew hold an Entrepreneur's day where members bring along their goodies to sell. Ten percent of the profit goes to the Group.
2. Write a programme for the Den/Pack dealing with money – showing how buying and selling and making a profit works.
OR
3. Write a programme for the Troop/Crew and let them discuss economic growth and unemployment.

Section 4: Sustainable Communities – SDG 11



Requirements:

Complete **ONE** requirement applicable to the branch you are working in:

1. Plan a joint outing to appreciate the culture and natural heritage and what to do to look after it.
2. Organise a speaker to talk about different careers in architecture, urban planning, etc.
3. Find out more about the Careers Expo.

The SDG Champion badge for Adults:

Scouts, Rovers and Adults who complete 8 individual SDG challenges over two or more years qualify for the SDG Champion badge. Any 4 badges you achieved as a Scout count when you are a Rover or Adult member, so you will be able to become an SDG Champion whenever you complete 8 individual challenges. Keep working to make positive changes in our world!
