The Challenge:

There are four sections to the 2021 challenge, covering the following Sustainable Development Goals:

Section 1: Clean Water and Sanitation – SDG 6

Requirements:

Complete requirement **number one** and **ONE** other requirement.

1. Design, build and donate a tippy tap to an Early Childhood Development Centre in your community. Use the tippy tap to demonstrate the correct way of washing hands with soap and water.
2. Learn how to purify grey water to make it safe to drink.
3. Make a poster explaining where water in your home comes from.
4. Teach the Cubs about the water cycle.



Section 2: Affordable and Clean Energy – SDG 7

Requirements:

Complete **TWO** of the following:

1. Explain the difference between renewable and non-renewable energy.
2. Describe five ways that you can save energy in your household.
3. Learn how to make paper ball fuels.
4. Earn the Conservation Interest badge.




Section 3: Decent work and economic growth – SDG 8

Requirements:

Complete **ONE** of the following:

1. Earn the Cub Entrepreneur Interest badge.
2. Plan and execute a fun career day as one of your Special Pack Meetings.



Section 4: Sustainable communities – SDG 11



Requirements:

Complete **TWO** of the following:

1. Explain the difference between air pollution and climate change.
2. Create a poster on how climate change can affect your community.
3. As a Pack, help your community to clean up your street and raise awareness on littering.
4. Find out about diseases caused by climate change.
5. Write six challenges of living in urban communities and six challenges of living in rural communities.
