



Job Description: Regional Coordinator: Land Activities

Role Purpose

To establish and maintain a Land Activities Committee in the Region to oversee and support the effective implementation of the Scout Advancement Programme in the Region in accordance with the Constitution, Organization Rules and Policies, with reference to Land Scouting and Land Activities and initiatives.

Functions

- To ensure the compliance to the Safe Scouting Policy within the Region.
- To ensure the planning of Regional Land Scout events in harmony with the Region Year at a Glance calendar.
- To assist with the planning of related training courses in harmony with the Region Training Programme.
- To support the development and maintenance of the Scout Programme through participation in the National Scout Programme Land Committee.
- To represent the interests and views of Land Scouts and Land Activities on the Regional Scout Team.
