

Job Description: Regional Coordinator: Water Activities

Role Purpose

To establish maintain and chair a Regional Water Activities Committee which will oversee, assist and support the effective implementation of the Sea Scouting and Water Activities parts of the Scout, Cub, and Rover Programs of SCOUTS South Africa (SSA), in accordance with the Constitution, Organization Rules and Policies.

Functions

- 1. To ensure:
 - a. compliance with the Safe Scouting Policy within the Region, with reference to the sections on water activities
 - b. the planning of regional sea scout events in harmony with and in consideration of District and Regional event planning
 - c. the planning of specific sea scout and water related youth training courses in harmony with and in consideration of District and Regional training schedules.
 - d. Support the RTC Adult Leader Training in the planning and running of Water activities training Courses, Charge Licence courses
 - e. that the committee supports the development and maintenance of the Scout, Cub and Rover Programs through participation in the National Scout Program Water Committee.
- 2. Attend where possible National Water Activities Committee meetings and liaise with the National Scout Programme: Coordinator for Water Activities
- 3. To represent the interests and views of Sea Scout Groups and Water Activities on the Regional Scout Team.
- 4. Perform / implement any project / task / assignment, as required by RTC Scout Programme.
- 5. Undergo an Individual Performance Review with the RTC Scout Programme

5 Years renewable for 3, and then 2 years. Thereafter the Warrant cannot be renewed for the role.
