Role Purpose

The Regional Scout Programme Team comprises members who do not hold a wood badge, but are assigned to support Groups in a Region, with the National Scout Programme Team.

The role of this team mirrors that of the National Scout Programme Team.

Functions

1. As per the National Scout Programme Team.
2. Perform / implement any project / task / assignment, as required by the Regional Coordinator: Scout Programme.
3. Undergo an annual Personal Development Review (PDR) with the Regional Coordinator: Scout Programme.
