



Job Description: Regional Support Team Member Water Activities

Role Purpose

To establish and maintain a Water Activities Committee to oversee and support the effective implementation of the Scout Advancement Programme in SCOUTS South Africa (SSA) in accordance with the Constitution, Organization Rules and Policies, with particular reference to Sea Scouting and Water Activities and initiatives.

Functions

To ensure the compliance to the Safe Scouting Policy within the Region, and in particular paragraphs 9.1 to 9.5.

To ensure the planning of Regional Sea Scout events in harmony with the Region Year at a Glance calendar.

To ensure the planning of specific sea scout related training courses in harmony with the Region Training Program.

To ensure that the committee supports the development and maintenance of the Scout Program through participation in the National Scout Program Water Committee.

To represent the interests and views of Sea Scouts and Water Activities on the Regional Scout Team.
