

Job Description: Support Team Member: Rovers

Role Purpose

To support the effective implementation of the Rover Programme in the Region in accordance with SCOUTS South Africa (SSA) Constitution, Organisational Rules and Policies.

To represent the interests and views of the Rover Programme at Regional Level.

Functions

- Support the implementation of the Rover Programme in the Region: 1.
 - a. Support the Regional Rover Advisory Council (RAC).
 - b. Monitor the progress (advancement, interest, recruitment and involvement) of Rovers in the assigned Crew from time to time.
 - c. Attend Regional and District Rover Programme events.
- Assist in managing Regional/District Rover events and activities 2.
 - Perform / implement any project / task / assignment, as required by the RTC: Rover a. Programme.
- 3. Monitor training and assessment standards in the Crew to which assigned:
 - Support the training and assessment processes for the Rover Advancement Programme. a.
 - Monitor the standards and processes for Baden-Powell Award (B-P Award) and Challenge b. Awards and provide advice where necessary.
 - c. Assist with Star Crew evaluations, and provide assistance and guidance where necessary.
 - d. Assist with Rover Wood Badge observations.
 - e. Provide assistance and guidance where necessary to Crews.
 - Support Youth Leadership Training in the Region to support the efforts of the Crew Councils f. and Rover Scouters in the implementation of Crews.
 - Support the Chair in the development and provision of the training material for use in Adult q. Training on modules specifically addressing the Rover Programme, and its implementation.
- Perform a support, supervisory and leadership role: 4.
 - a. Identify potential members for the Rover Support Team in the Region.
 - Interpret and apply SSA Policy and Directives related to Rover Programmes. b.
- 5. Provide input to the on-going improvement, development and implementation of the Rover The second second second

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Programme.

- 6. Perform / implement any project / task / assignment, as required by the RTC: Rover Programme.
- 7. Have a meeting with RTC Rover Programme, at least annually, to discuss the successes and challenges in their Region.
